STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP CRITERION

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded to deserving Medina Valley High School Seniors who have demonstrated academic competence and who are dedicated to the pursuit of a college education.
- 2. "Need" can be one criterion, but should not be the dominant one. It is important to complete all parts of the application. The (SAR) Student Aid Report is generated from submission of FAFSA. Only the first page with the Expected Family Contribution is needed (EFC)
- 3. The recipients should have academic credentials that are acceptable to the school of their choice.
- 4. The scholarship funds will be in the form of a check, made to the college, university and/or trade school with the student's name and college ID on the memo line. The checks will be mailed directly to the college/university/school and must be used within 1 year.
- 5. Recipients of this scholarship award must enroll full time (minimum of 12 credit hours) according to the standards of the appropriate university/college/school.
